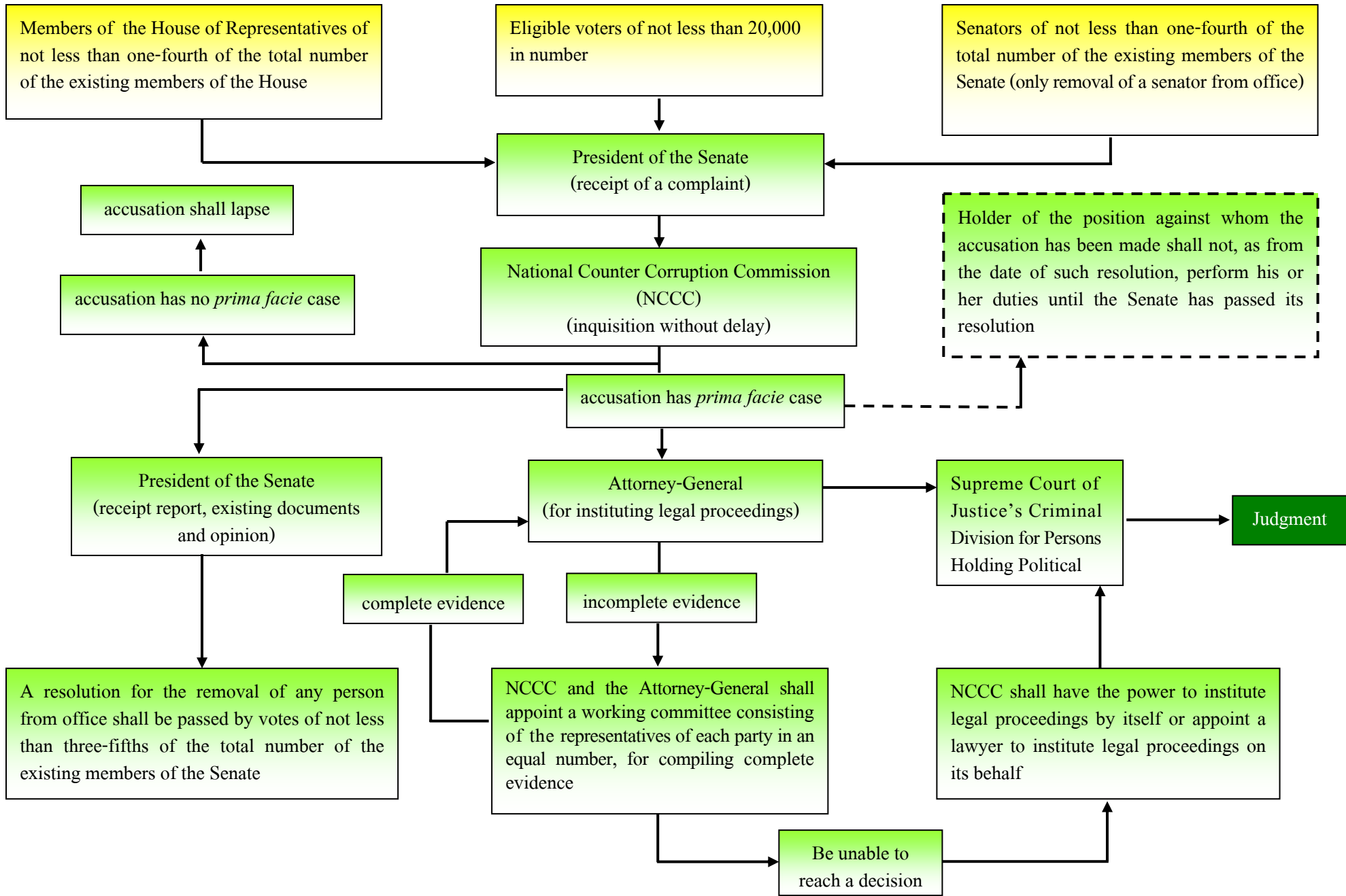
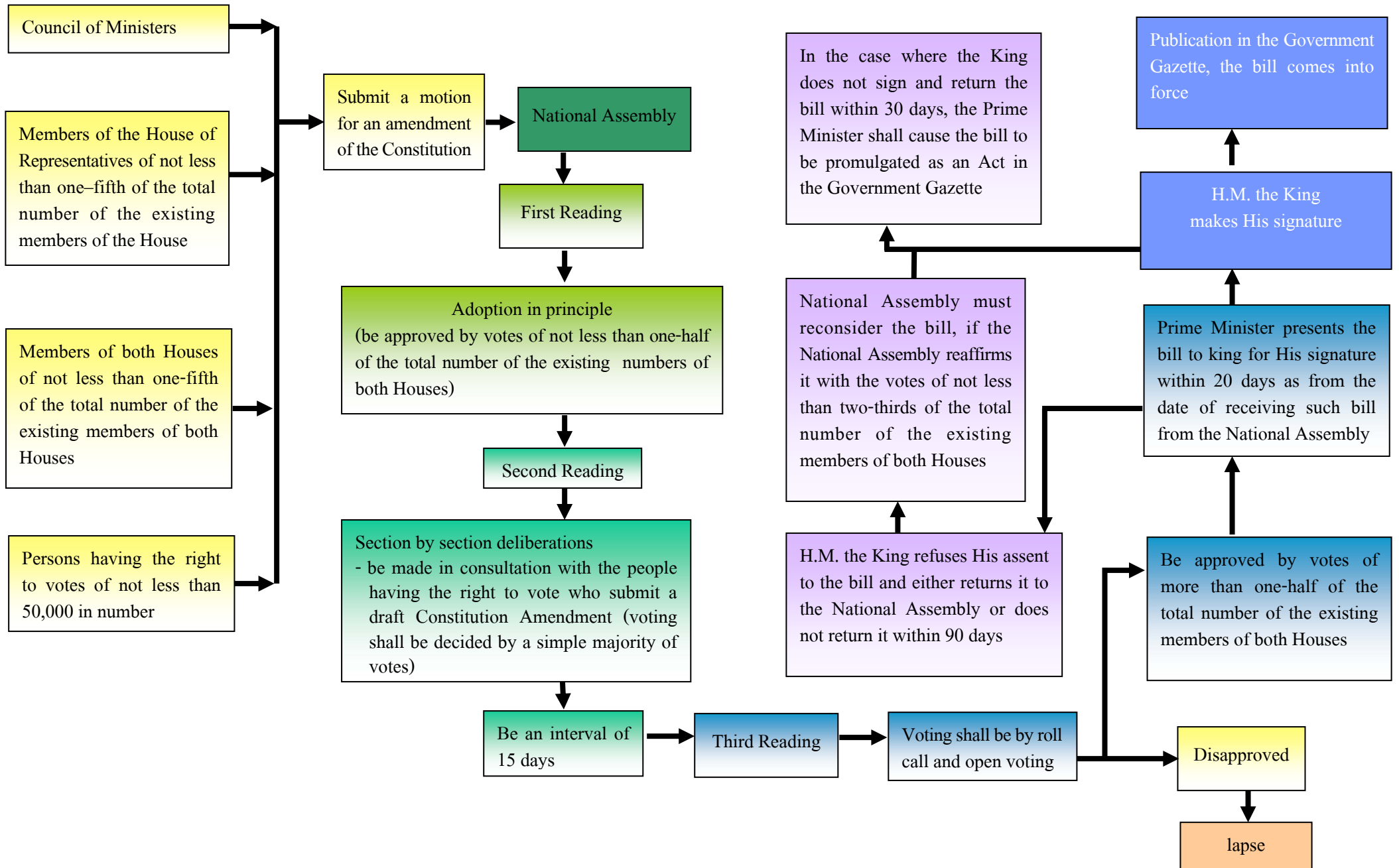

Removal from Offices

Accusation (section 270)

1. unusual wealthiness
2. indicative of the commission of corruption
3. indicative of malfeasance in office
4. indicative of malfeasance in judicial office
5. indicative of an intentional exercise of power contrary to the provisions of the Constitution or law
6. serious violation or failure to comply with ethical standard

Alleged Persons (section 270)

1. Prime Minister
2. Minister
3. member of the House of Representatives
4. senator
5. President of the Supreme Court of Justice
6. President of the Constitutional Court
7. President of the Supreme Administrative Court
8. Attorney-General
9. judge of the Constitutional Court
10. Election Commissioner
11. Ombudsman
12. member of the State Audit Commission
13. judge
14. State attorney
15. high ranking official in accordance with the Organic Act on Counter Corruption

Result of the Removal from Offices (section 274 paragraph two)

A person who is removed from office shall vacate office or be discharged from government service as from the date of the resolution the Senate. Such person shall be deprived of the right to hold any political position or to serve in the government service for five years.
